

NEWS:TIGERS BREAK SCHOOL SCORING RECORD IN VICTORY

The Marple Newtown Tigers ran their record to 3-0 overall and 2-0 in the Central League on Saturday, with a 62-6 victory over host Lower Merion. The Aces (0-3, 0-2) couldn't stop the Tigers potent grand attack and struggled to move the ball all afternoon. The team also etched their names into the school record books as the 62 points scored topped the previous record of 55.

Senior back John Gallagher found the end zone 3 times on the afternoon, giving him 7 scores in the first 3 games of the season. Quarterback Steve Giordano scored on touchdown on the ground and threw for one, completing the pass to Tight End Kenny Clark. John Rutecki, Sam Hafez and Joe Carini also added scores on the ground for the Tigers. Hafez finished the day with 14 points (1 TD, 8/9 PAT).

The Tigers defense turned in another solid effort, stifling Lower Merion's offense throughout the game. Senior Brandon Rook had an interception and Jay Trio pounced on a fumble for Marple Newtown. Dan Giordano, Pete Massaro, and Brian Hulsey helped anchor the Tigers defense.
