TIGERS DROP PLAYOFF OPENER TO UNIONVILLE, 21-19

One of the finest seasons in school history came to an end on Friday evening, as Unionville stopped the Tigers with a 21-19 victory. Marple Newtown finished the 2006 campaign with an 8-3 record, including the first PIAA playoff appearance in school history.

Running backs John Rutecki and John Gallagher paced the Tigers offense. Rutecki rushed for two touchdowns (2 yards, 3 yards) and 153 yards. John Gallagher added the Tigers final score with a 28 yard fourth quarter burst.

Another fine defensive effort was turned in by the now infamous "Wolfpack" defensive line. Seniors Perry Koliatsis, Dave Hansell and Shane Breslin helped control the potent Indian offensive attack for most of the night. Linebackers Pat Aigeldinger and Trevor Viviani also turned in fine efforts for the Tigers.
