# Marple rips Royals

UPPER DARBY - One of Upper Darby High's football fans found a curious way to express his wishes Saturday.

His sign, hanging over the front rail of the Royals' stands, said simply: "Miracles can happen." sentiments

Actually, the weren't out of place.

The Royals were playing un-defeated Central League rival Marple Newtown, one of the top rated teams in the area. As it turned out, they could have filled the water buckets with holy water, stuffed rosaries in their pockets and hung rabbit's feel around their necks and still come up short.

Marple Newtown, after a slug-gish start, steamrolled to a 34-6 over the outmanned victory Royals.

The Tigers needed their defense to get them uncranked as the underdog Royals kept the visitors bottled up for a good portion of the first half.

On the Royals' first series of the game, Joe Grande fumbled and Gil Maze of the Tigers scooped up the ball and rambled 31 yards for a touchdown.

Later in the first period, Upper Darby quarterback Scott Hadfield was jolted while attempting to

## CONDOMINIUM-COOPERATIVE-THE DIFFERENCE

Did you ever wonder about the difference between a condominium and a cooperative? In a condominium, you get actual title to the space within your unit plus an undivided interest along with other owners to the structure, grounds and common elements (pool, parking area, hallways, recreational area.

In a cooperative, the "co-op" corporation owns everything within the complex including your unit and you get stock in the corporation plus a lease to your unit. In effect, co-aps do not enjoy the same favorable mortgage treatment by banks as you get when you own and have title to your condominium or home.
